Pursuant to a congressional request, GAO reviewed the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) efforts to prevent, detect, and recover compensation and pension overpayments. GAO found that: (1) in 1994, VA detected about 372 million in overpayments to its beneficiaries mainly due to changes in income, particularly changes related to social security benefits; (2) although VA recovers about 30 percent of its overpayments, its outstanding overpayment balance was about 618 million in 1994; (3) many beneficiaries do not have the resources to repay the overpayments; (4) although VA has the capability to prevent many overpayments, it has not focused on overpayment prevention; (5) VA needs to better coordinate its beneficiary information with that of the Social Security Administration; and (6) VA does not systematically collect, analyze, and use information on the specific causes of overpayments to target its preventive efforts.
