This is an increase of 7 per cent over the 15,257 now belonging. A deduction of 750 pupils is made because of the Barbour and Hutchins intermediate schools. The total amount requested for high school instruction is \$1,694,820. This is a decrease of \$148,363 from the estimated 1921-1922 expenditures. The decrease from amount allowed is accounted for as follows: 1. Wilkins high school of Commerce which was included in amount allowed, 1921-1922, is asked for this year in the division, Vocational Instruction. 2. An allowance is made in this budget for ninth grade pupils who will be in Hutchins and Barbour intermediate schools next year. 3.
