As they did with Pick a Circle, Gather Squares (shapes), Cheers for a Dozen Ears (counting), and Sun Above and Blooms Below (opposites), Felicia Sanzari Chernesky and Susan Swan again introduce a basic learning subject for prereaders colors, in this case through a family outing in the country: "'We're going to the farm,' Dad said. 'You want to know the reason? To hunt for winter's hidden gold it's maple syrup season!'" Gray skies, brown coats, blue sleigh tracks, a red cardinal, an orange carrot nose on a snowman, green trees, pink cheeks, purple shadows, a silver pail, and the amber syrup itself are the colors called out here, in vibrant digital collages full of visual texture and detail." Written in easy rhyme, the mellow text pairs well with Swan's realistic artwork, which places the story in a lovely winter setting, reinforcing the color concepts in her indoor and outdoor scenes."
